

Stairlift rental advice

When you rent a stairlift, you pay a fee, (usually monthly), to have a hired stairlift installed in your house.

Having a stairlift installed is a good solution to help you regain independence at home lost through lack of mobility. This may be because of an ongoing condition such as arthritis, old age, or a more temporary setback such as recovering from an operation.

In fact a temporary stairlift rental is an ideal option if you are recovering from an illness or procedure which incapacitates you from ascending or descending stairs in the short term. Having a temporary rented stairlift installed is also beneficial for relatives or guests who come to stay with you who cannot use stairs.

There are various types of stairlift and it is important that you choose the one which best suits your current and future needs.

How much does it cost to hire a temporary stairlift?

The cost of renting a straight stairlift should normally not exceed £10 a week for a straight stairlift but will be more for a curved one as they are custom-built for the staircase and cannot be reused after the rental period is over.
